WHAT'S THE JOB ABOUT?

- Treating and preventing diseases in animals
 Diagnosis and treatment of injury/illness, prescription of medications, surgery, vaccination, dietary recommendations, euthanasia
- Advising farmers and pet owners
 Flock/herd health programs, feeding/breeding strategies, certifying soundness for breeding and performance programs
- Specialising in particular types of animals or fields in veterinary science
 Large and small livestock, pets/companion animals, native and exotic species

WORK CONDITIONS

- Veterinarians can work in private practice or for government departments, universities, research organisations and large companies.
- Work may take place in a veterinary surgery, on farms and at racing/stabling facilities, quarantine stations, research facilities, zoos and wildlife sanctuaries.
- Veterinarians often work long and irregular hours including being on call at nights and on weekends.
- The job is very practical and uses applied scientific research.
- Opportunities exist to travel both within Australia and overseas to work and attend conferences.
- Sufficient funds or financial backing are essential to purchase/ lease premises and establish a veterinary practice.
- Small business management skills are essential for the successful operation of a veterinary practice.

EXPERIENCE AND RELATED TRAINING

- To be employed as veterinarian you must have a degree in Veterinary Science.
- Specialisation usually occurs through postgraduate studies.

Career path	Training Requirements
Veterinarian	TERTIARY EDUCATION
You undertake a number of the above tasks working in a private practice or for government agencies, institutions or drug companies.	Degree in Veterinary Science (or equivalent)
Principal of a Veterinary Practice	TERTIARY EDUCATION
You own and operate a veterinary practice, usually employing staff such as other veterinarians and veterinary nurses.	Degree in Veterinary Science (or equivalent)
Consultant Veterinarian	TERTIARY EDUCATION
You have specialised in a particular field of veterinary science and provide advice and specialist skills to veterinarians and other clients.	Post graduate degree (Masters /PhD) in a field related to veterinary science or other specialist area.
