WHAT'S THE JOB ABOUT?

Working with animals

Working with horses, bikes, dogs to muster livestock; handling and looking after livestock in yards and feedlots

- Operating a range of machinery and equipment
 Motorcycles; ATV's; tractors; farm vehicles; small engines
- Carrying out a wide range of outdoor tasks
 Maintaining fences, yards, sheds, stock water supplies

WORK CONDITIONS

- Farm work is very practical and usually outdoors. Depending on the season and activity the hours can be irregular and long.
- On larger properties some workers can specialise in livestock or machinery and cropping.

EXPERIENCE AND RELATED TRAINING

- To be employed as a farm hand you will usually need to have some experience or training.
- You can undertake vocational training before starting a job or in a traineeship whilst working.
- Employers will provide on-the-job induction and training and may require you to do some vocational training.
- If you are already working at this level, you can have your skills recognised by applying for a qualification with a training provider.
- Check whether there are training or licensing requirements in your state or territory to do some tasks such as using chemicals or chainsaws, operating a front-end loader or driving a vehicle.

Career path	Training Requirements
Farm assistant	VOCATIONAL TRAINING
Doing a range of the above tasks you would normally work under supervision with a more experienced person or the boss.	Certificate 2 in Agriculture
Station hand	VOCATIONAL TRAINING
You work with much less supervision on your own or in a team and can make some decisions when doing the above tasks.	Certificate 3 in Agriculture
Senior station hand	VOCATIONAL TRAINING
You make decisions about how the above tasks will be done, organise and supervise other workers and report to the farm owner or manager.	Certificate 4 in Agriculture
