#### WHAT'S THE JOB ABOUT?

#### Specialising in working with livestock

Mustering, drafting, carrying out husbandry operations, weaning, monitoring lambing/ calving and stock health.

#### Mustering livestock

Usually done using horses or bikes and with sheep dogs. On larger sheep stations mustering may be done in combination with ultra lights or gyrocopters.

• Some property maintenance and/or equipment operation may be required.

#### **WORK CONDITIONS**

- Farm work is very practical and usually outdoors. Depending on the season and activity the hours can be irregular and long.
- Meat processors employ stockmen to work in their yards and on associated properties.
- Stockmen often need to provide their own horses and working dogs.





## Farming

### EXPERIENCE AND RELATED TRAINING

- To be employed as a stockman you will usually need to have some experience or training.
- You can undertake vocational training before starting a job or in a traineeship whilst working.
- Employers will provide on-the-job induction and training and may require you to do some vocational training.
- If you are already working at this level you can have your skills recognised by applying for a qualification with a training provider.
- Check whether there are training or licensing requirements in your state to do some tasks such as using chemicals or chainsaws, operating a front-end loader or driving a vehicle.

Career path	Training Requirements
Stockman/Ringer	VOCATIONAL TRAINING
You work with some supervision on your own or in a team and can make some decisions when working with livestock.	Certificate 3 in Agriculture
Head Stockman	VOCATIONAL TRAINING
You make decisions about how the livestock work will be done, organise and supervise other workers and report to the farm owner or manager.	Certificate 4 in Agriculture
