Function of sheep skin

- Skin has a number of functions
- The ability to functionally perform is determined by the structural components of the skin
 - each component has a specific function in relation to the whole animal
- Some functions can directly influence wool production



Skin as a simple boundary

- Skin provides protection against:
 - injury
 - predacious enemies
 - invasion of micro-organisms
 - radiation



Skin as an active boundary

- functional boundary
 - water regulation
 - -insulation
 - absorption and excretion of materials
 - supply sensory information
